

Uniform Standards

Below is a list of beginner patches and their proper placement on the student's uniform. We recommend lining up the patches while the student is wearing the uniform before sewing them in place. This ensures the patches appear in the correct position when the uniform is worn.

- Victory Patch – All Karate Kids and Tiny Tigers receive this patch upon becoming a member. The patch is shaped like a “V” with a circle in the center featuring the Karate Kid or Tiny Tiger logo. It should be sewn on the left chest.
- Black Belt Club Patch – This triangular patch is awarded to all students when they join as full members. It should be sewn on the left sleeve, just below the shoulder seam, resting above the elbow and positioned on the outside of the shoulder when the uniform is worn.

Uniform tops are tied across the body with the ATA side on the inside. Belts are tied so that knowledge stripes, or the stripes earned in class are be on the left side. Rank stripes (Single High Stripe) on belts should be on the right side.

If a student's sleeves or pant legs are too long, they should be rolled under so that the roll is not visible. A few tack stitches to hold rolls in place is recommended so they do not come undone during class.

for safety all jewelry should be removed prior to the beginning of class. Female students are required to wear a white t-shirt under their uniform. White t-shirts are optional for males. No other colors or style of shirt (collared polo, sweatshirt, etc) is permitted under the uniform.
